Take on the **High Ropes** course and climb and abseil. Go underground and visit one of the regions best **Caves**. Take in the beauty of **Australias Raptors** and watch a magical aerial display.

Cape to Cape Education in partnership with **SurfLifeSaving WA** are able to offer exclusive access to their training facility in the heart of Margaret River with easy access to the main town and surrounding bushland.

Staff and students will stay in a clean and functional purpose built site with access to **sports equipment, classroom** and a full **commercial kitchen** with cool room.

On an evening the classroom doubles as a great cinema room and at the right time of year the outdoor firepit creates a great focal point for a campfire singalong and the obligatory marshmallows.

- The accommodation provides **Dorm style** rooms for students with a capacity of **74 beds**: Dorms are available in a variety of sizes including 3 Bed, 4 Bed and 8 Bed rooms
- Separate Male and female washrooms and toilets along with Ambundant facilities are available
- **Staff** have the option of staying on site in the private block known as Boodjidup House which can accommodate **8 Staff** in their own private rooms or **16 staff sharing** – Boodjidup house also offers in house laundry, kitchen & living room along with Male and Female washrooms and toilets.
- Guests are required to bring their own single bed linen, towels, toiletries for all accomodation on site.

All catering is provided by Cape to Cape Explorers in-house catering team with a selection of hearty and seasonal dishes to keep the student's fueled up for adventure.

Note: Dietaries can be accomodated – Including various GF, DF, Veg & Vegan options

Breakfast – Continental Style: A mix of cereals, toast, breakfast muffins, croissants, fruit, yoghurt etc

Morning Tea – A mixture of Cakes, muffins & delicious snacks

Lunch – Sandwiches & wraps with a selection of salads, cheeses and meats & fruit

Dinner – Wholesome evening meals (seasonal) with a mixture of options including nachos, lasagna, pasta, curry, pies, burgers, BBQ etc

All evening meals come with a delicious home made dessert

Note: School staff will be required to reheat, and serve evening meals, lunches will be provided in a Make Your Own method and staff will need to supervise – we do not provide a serving team

The SurfLifeSaving WA' Main **Student** accommodation includes:

- Two 3 bed dorms
- Nine 4 bed dorms
- Four 8 bed dorms
- Large outdoor area with plenty of space for sports and games
- Classroom with TV and HDMI laptop connections
- Outdoor Firepit (Available May to October)

Boodjidup House (**Staff**) accommodation includes:

- Veranda with barbecue, table and chairs
- Common room (loungue area) with TV and DVD player
- Private or shared staff rooms (8-16 capacity)
- Large kitchen with all appliances and crockery/glassware
